Austin Lee has been a MSXC regular for several years. From his days on a 65, two MSXC championships, and now racing a KTM 105 in the Junior A class, he has seen many victories.

Round two of the MSXC Winter Series would be no exception as the Performance Supercycle/Moose Racing/Johnny Signs backed rider, grabbed the holeshot and quickly took advantage of the dusty race conditions by jumping out to a big early lead.

So big, he had a 44 second lead by the time he came through the scoring tent on lap one. He managed to literally leave the competition “in the dust” throughout the 60 minute race and added another minute to his already 44 second lead. It was definitely Lee's day as he cruised to an easy win. Second place went to Brandon Gourley and coming in third was Tanner Mccoy.

In the Junior B 85cc class KTM rider Brock Oakley, pictured below, pulled out his first Winter Series win over Cole Kirchoff and Justin Lenard.



Oakley grabbed the MSXC holeshot with fellow KTM racer Lenard hot on his wheels. Close behind Lenard was Obermeyer Yamaha rider Cole Kirchoff.

The trio of racers fought hard with each other every lap and at the end of the race, Kirchoff had put in the fastest lap of all three riders and managed to get by Lenard for second place. Kirchoffs' late race charge was not enough to catch a last lap push by Oakley though. Oakley had secured his first win of the season and said afterward “ Man it was dusty, but I am glad I won”
