









Elrod Rules Little Egypt

Round 6: 12-05-10 Marion III. "The Egyptian" AMA Mid-South Youth Cross Country Championship Series

The 50cc Youth class saw a big change for the 10/11 Winter Season. The class went back to a combined format for all 50 riders as it used to be originally.

Garrett Elrod and Dylan Proffitt have been battling back and forth all season for the Championship. Jeremy Lenard usually mixes it up with them but due to the injury to his brother, he missed this race.



Elrod grabbed the holeshot and pulled out to a small lead on the first few laps. Midway through the race though, Proffitt came on strong and narrowed the gap on laps 5 and 6.



As the race wound down, it was clear either racer could win. The pair pushed each other all the way to the scoring tent and at the finish, it was KTM mounted Elrod overcoming the Cobra rider Proffitt for the win. It was so close, they both have the exact same time down to the second! It doesn't get any tighter than that.

In doing so, Elrod has a slim 5 point lead after drops now for the class Championship.

The next stop is the big two day Triple Sanction in Maplesville Alabama on January 8th and 9th. The 50 class riders will definitely have more competition down south! Maplesville historically has the biggest youth turnout of the season.
